I'm sure many of you watched the daily Coronavirus briefing yesterday where the government announced that the 5 tests that had been set out have been met. As a result, I can confirm that the plans that we sent out on Tuesday 19th May can be put in place on Monday 1st June. Please re check the letter for days and times for your year group.

Just a few reminders:

- All children will enter through the main gate. There will be chalked crosses on the pavement leading from the main gate so a socially distanced queue can be formed. A member of staff will be at the gate at all times. For safety reasons, can I please ask that you do not park anywhere near the school or roundabout and if you are able to walk to school, it would be really appreciated.
- Please do not arrive too early or late as staggered start times and finish times have been carefully planned to avoid groups that are too large being near school at the same time. For the same reason, can you make sure only one adult does the drop off and pick up.
- If you are happy for your Y6 child to walk home on their own, please let your child's class teacher know via seesaw if you have not already done so.
- Finally, if your child needs an inhaler or epipen or any other medication that we already know about, can you please ensure they have that with them.
